*Shakele will attend the University of Pennsylvania with full scholarship support. She plans to study Chemical Engineering.*

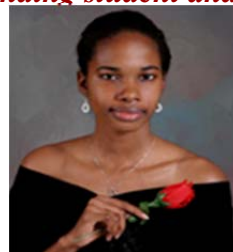
## ***Salutatorian Class of 2011*** **Nyanka Joseph**

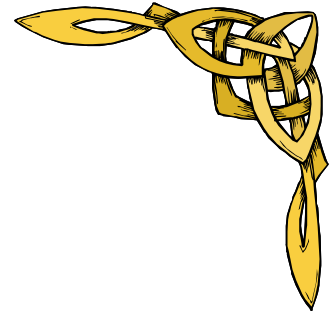
